Submission guide lines:

The RCOM'24 Conference invites researchers, doctoral students, and practitioners to submit extended abstracts for potential presentation at the conference. These extended abstracts should be 2000 words in length and must adhere to the following guidelines:

Content Structure:

- Objective- Clearly state the study's objective or purpose.
- Methodology: Describe the research methodology employed.
- Key Results: Present the main findings of the study.
- Discussion: Engage in a discussion or analysis of the results.
- Implications: Discuss the implications of the findings.
- Key References: Include relevant references to support your work.

Review Process:

- Submitted abstracts will undergo a blind review process
- Only abstracts that receive acceptance from reviewers will be selected for presentation at the conference.

Formatting Guidelines:

Font Style: Times New Roman

Font Size: 12-Point

• Font Size: 12-Point

• Space between Line and Paragraph: 1.5

 Margins: 1-inch (2.5cm) margin all around.

Document Type: PDF

• The similarity index for the submitted extended abstract should not exceed 10%, excluding references.

Authors Information:

- Provide full affiliations for all authors without using abbreviations.
- Include contact information for the presenting author


